Your final submission must include the following:

1. Project Title- Provide a clear and concise title.
2. Team Details

Include:

- Team and University name
 - Full name of each team member
 - University name
 - Registration number
 - Contact number and email address
3. Abstract (Max 250 words)- Summarize your idea: Background, Objective, Method, Expected Outcomes.
 4. Problem Statement & Relevance (Max 100 words)- What issue are you addressing, and why is it important?
 5. Proposed Solution (Max 100 words)- Outline the key idea and how it addresses the problem.
 6. Expected Social Impact (Max 100 words)- Describe the positive outcomes expected from implementing this idea
 7. Feasibility & Sustainability (50–100 words)- How realistic is your idea, and can it scale or be sustained long-term?
 8. Visuals / Prototypes- Attach illustrations or process flows (if available).
 9. PowerPoint Presentation & Video Pitch- Record a 5-minute pitch video (can be voice-over slides or team presentation).

Provide a YouTube or Google Drive link to your video.

- Implementation plan
- Use of technology

- Commercial or social value
- Include a short video clip demonstrating the practical application of your innovation (e.g., prototype in use, simulation, or concept demonstration). This can be embedded in your pitch video or one-minute separate pitch video.
